Reminder:

8A5(f) Non-competitor on course

Not permitted to start/DSQ

Do not enter any of the courses for inspection, pre-ride or warm up from any location other than the Start/Finish area, and then only when the Announcer informs you the course is open. Riders who enter the course before the announcer invites them on will be disqualified and not allowed to race.

General Warnings:

Respect for the communities and other race participants:

8A5(b) Foul and/abusive language.

DSQ/Fines/possible recommendation for suspension

8B5(c) Littering

\$50 and relegation or disqualification

Racers at the ChicagoGrit events are guests in these communities. The use of foul and abusive language is disrespectful to the families who live here. Littering on the course is prohibited. Keep the community clean! They don't want the gel packs you toss. **Pocket it and pack it out.** Help these races be welcomed back in the communities that host the events!

Bib pick up each day is at the side window of the large white motorhome “Command Center” near the Finish Line.

Personal Tents: All team tents must be properly weighted (and not tied to any fire hydrants, etc). Tents will be inspected by the fire dept (especially in Lombard). Those failing compliance must be taken down.

Weather: Be self sufficient and bring plenty of water. ChicagoGRIT cannot provide water for participants and/or spectators. The AQI at this time in Mundelein is 119, with the forecast for tomorrow currently indicating air quality that is adequate for most people.
